26/06/01 Apologies – Cllr Adams, Cllr Barnes and PC Sue Brookes

26/06/02 Councillors Declaration of Interest - None

26/06/03 Minutes of the last meeting 1<sup>st</sup> May approved

**Public participation**

26/06/04 Banking and Finance:-

- Current financial position – Current Acct - £1320.30, Road Maintenance Acct £34452.30 (plus £110 to be paid in), Savings Acct £883.34
- Figures and internal control questions signed off and minuted for the annual audit.
- Cheques already signed in between meetings Farm and Land £82.80, Insurance £436.24, YLCA vacancy advert £15. Agreed to be signed when cheque is returned from internal auditor:- Clerks salary for 8 weeks £218.16, Room hire £24

26/06/05 Traffic calming – VAS Survey update from Highways done but figures/channels need splitting out to show if people drive faster in one direction rather than the other – results to be given at next meeting - AGREED

26/06/06 Planning:

- Point 26/06/09 moved up agenda – Gladman - Boroughbridge Road development appeal hearing update - Ref APP/E2734/A/13/2207338 – Cllr Patterson updated the council on the proceedings that took place at the Appeal Hearing and that a decision should hopefully be made by the Inspectorate in the next two weeks.
- Variation of condition 2 of planning permission 6.94.51.T.FUL to allow the installation of a door to the gable end of Plot 3. Park Corner Farm – The council responded with NO OBJECTION
- HBC Office Project consultation – The majority view was for SPC not to respond to this consultation - AGREED

26/06/07 Private Roads – to discuss:

- Road maintenance collection – outstanding contributions Beech Lodge and Ivy Cottage – Clerk to get in touch with Mrs Armitage re collection - AGREED
- Update on repair schedule - the 2 repair dates have been booked in with HACS by Mr Ellis for Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> August for the top end of the road (Armitage) and Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> of August for the bottom end of the road (Parish Council) - residents will need to be informed in advance by letter from SPC - AGREED and HACS will have to ensure that roads are kept clear.

- 26/06/08 Clerk Vacancy Applications – SPC have had two applications. SPC to contact both to invite them for interviews. AGREED  
Clerk to check on room availability at Park Grove AGREED
- 26/06/10 World War One commemoration – Family history story from Cllr Bell to be published in the next newsletter. Cllr Patterson and Cllr Fox to submit WW1 stories for future newsletters to help encourage local residents to submit theirs - AGREED
- 26/06/11 Jacob Smith Park – Nothing to report
- 26/06/12 Website update – hits and usage still good especially at weekends.
- 26/06/13 Correspondence – information received regarding the Scriven Chronicles – Document received from previous and current residents. Several Bradley family members appreciated the work that had gone into producing the Scriven Chronicles but felt strongly that they wanted to correct some misquoted and inaccurate information relating to the Bradley family. SPC to file the document with the book held in the Parish Council files – AGREED
