13/03/05 Traffic calming – Highways have agreed to redo traffic survey as they made an error with location of the monitoring device on the previous survey. As it has been found to be owned by Highways, SPC to write to request permission to place a SLOW DOWN sign on the end of the wall in front of Coney Garth View. AGREED

13/03/06 Planning:

- Park Corner Farm application for amendments to previous permitted plans Ref. No. 6.94.51.W.DVCON 13/04384 incomplete item from last meeting – SPC Objected
- Park Corner Farm development access road naming proposal – SPC submitted a preference for just ‘Park Corner’ rather than HBC’s proposed name of ‘Park Corner Lane’. HBC proposed ‘Park Corner Fold’ as an alternative
- Protected Tree works application no. 6.94.81.B.TPO 14/00222/TPO – SPC submitted No Objections – HBC has consented with conditions
- Park Corner Farm application to rebuild the Barn East Wing application no. 6.94.51.W. FUL 14/00778/FUL – SPC have no objections to the planned rebuild but request the Biodiversity report is revisited with regards to bats, as they have been present on this site.

13/03/07 Private Roads – to discuss:

- Update on current condition – Cllr Sykes has recently done a road survey. Clerk to re-check liability insurance cover for the private roads - AGREED

- Repair proposal from Mr Ellis – has been accepted by the residents – SPC to send a letter requesting contributions of £35 from all relevant residents, to fulfil the fund shortfall required – a group of residents volunteered, at the parish meeting, to collect any cheques that don't get delivered to the clerk within the month. AGREED. Farmland owners to pay £75 as before AGREED
- Residents Road Maintenance Group – to be considered at future meetings AGREED

- 13/03/08 Minerals and Waste – Issues and options consultation – SPC have no further comments to add to this consultation, at this time
- 13/03/09 Boroughbridge Road development appeal meeting update - Ref APP/E2734/A/13/2207338 – SPC representative to attend and speak at appeal hearing. Put on agenda for next meeting. AGREED
- 13/03/10 World War One commemoration – discuss possible remembrance activities – put on agenda for further discussion at the next meeting AGREED
